

Short Biography

A former Professor of Economics at University College London and at Stockholm University, Fabrizio Zilibotti (born 07.09.1964) currently holds the Chair of Macroeconomics and Political Economy of the Department of Economics at the University of Zurich. He is the elected President of the European Economic Association for the year 2016. He is the Scientific Director and Deputy Director of the UBS International Center of Economics in Society. He is a joint recipient of the Yrjö Jahnsson 2009 award from the European Economic Association and of the Sun Yefang 2012 Award from the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences (prize granted for the paper "Growing Like China"). He is the main editor of the *Journal of the European Economic Association*, a former director and managing editor of the *Review of Economic Studies*, and an Associate Editor of the *Journal of Economic Growth*. He is the Principal Investigator of an ERC Advanced Grant. He is a director of the NBER Economic Fluctuations Group on Income Distribution and Macroeconomics. He is a Fellow of the Econometric Society, CEPR and CESifo. His research interests include economic growth and development, political economy, macroeconomics, financial economics, and industrial organization. He has published papers in *all* top-five journals in economics: *American Economic Review*, *Econometrica*, *Journal of Political Economy*, *Quarterly Journal of Economics*, *Review of Economic Studies*. In addition, he has published papers (among others) in *Economic Journal*, *European Economic Review*, *International Economic Review*, *Journal of Monetary Economics*, *Journal of Economic Theory*, *Journal of Economic Growth*, *Journal of the European Economic Association*.
